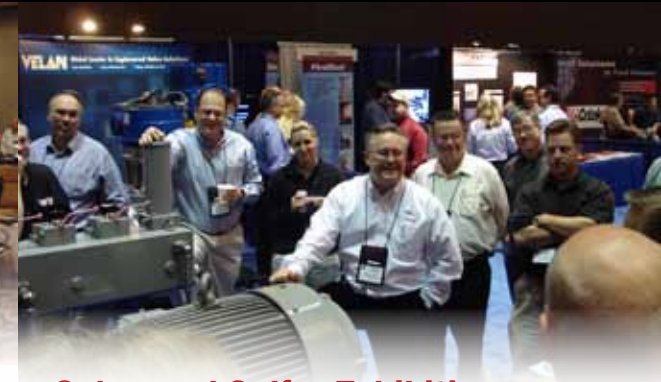
Building the Sulfur Community
